St Teresa International University is pleased to announce the opening of admissions for the **Graduate Diploma in Teaching Profession (International Program) Academic Year 2025**.

1. Accreditation by Teachers Council of Thailand

The program has held accreditation since 2014 and has consistently maintained this status. As the only university offering this international teaching program, it has demonstrated a sustained commitment to high academic and professional standards. Graduates who successfully complete the program are eligible to receive a teaching license from the Teachers' Council of Thailand.

2. Application Schedule, Selection, and Announcement of Results (Please note that the schedule is subject to change as deemed appropriate)

- 2.1 Applications will be accepted until 13 October 2025.
- 2.2 All submitted credentials will be reviewed, and application fee payments will be verified.
- 2.3 Interview schedules will be emailed on 14 October 2025.
- 2.4 The interview will be conducted online individually on 15 October 2025.
- 2.5 Interview results will be announced via email on 15 October 2025.
- 2.6 Successful applicants must confirm enrollment by paying the first semester fee starting from 15th October 2025 to 18th October, 2025.

3. Applicants working as teachers in schools, please submit the following documents in the form of photographs or scanned files:

- 3.1 Certificate and Transcript of Records of Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree (if any) in any academic discipline from an accredited institution.
- 3.2 For non-native English speakers, certificates of English Language Proficiency Test results (TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS, etc.).
- 3.3 Passport photo, sized 1" or 2", taken in full-face view, directly facing the camera without hat and sunglasses.
- 3.4 Application Fee (non-refundable) Baht 4,000.
- 3.5 Passport (bio page and the latest visa stamp).
- 3.6 Valid Work Permit first page and the latest permit stamp page.
- 3.7 Temporary Teaching Permit /License issued by the Teacher's Council (Khurusapha).
- 3.8 Current School Employment Contract in a K-12 School.

4. Program duration and Class schedule

The program spans 1.5 years, divided into 3 terms. Classes will be held exclusively on weekends, either on Saturdays or Sundays, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. However, during the second and third term, students must participate in internship at local schools in order to gain real-world teaching experience **(for teachers, their existing school can also be used as an internship training)**.

3. Guidelines for Teaching Profession Internship courses 146 202 and 146 203

3.1 Arrange work as a school teacher in a recognized school that teaches basic education, including childhood, primary, secondary, or in a higher secondary school.

3.2 Must perform duties as a teacher teaching in a recognized school according to item 1 for not less than 6 hours per week and other administrative work not less than 10 hours per week.

3.3 School that allows teachers enrolled in the program to do Internship should have a supervisor who holds a teaching license.
