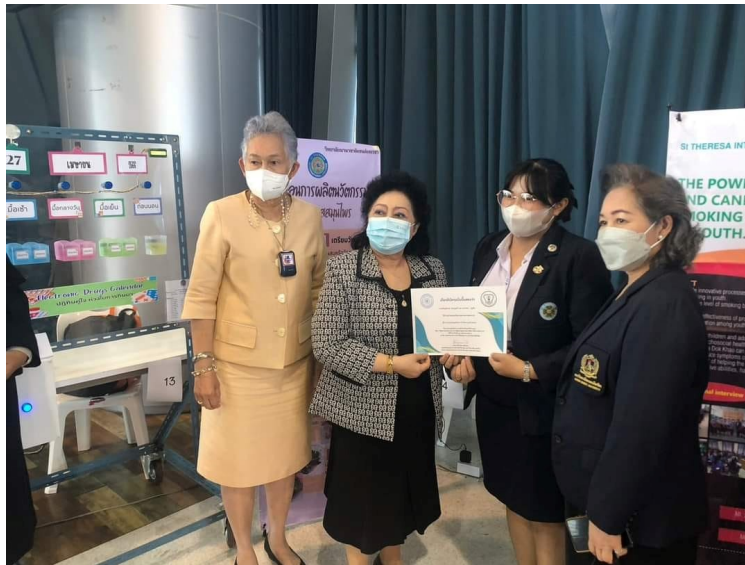
Dorm Night

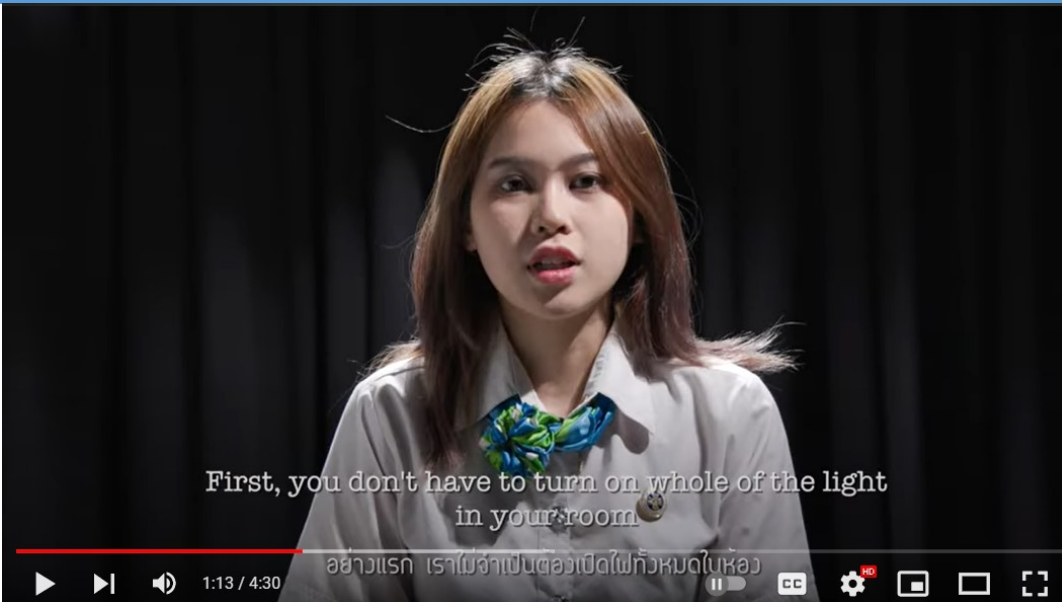
