St Teresa International University is pleased to announce the opening of admissions for the **Graduate Diploma in Teaching Profession (International Program) Academic Year 2026**.

1. Accreditation by Teachers Council of Thailand

Since 2014, the program has maintained continuous accreditation and a strong record of academic quality. As the only university offering this Graduate Diploma in Teaching Profession (International program for foreign teachers), it upholds rigorous professional standards through regular curriculum review and compliance with national regulatory frameworks. The program's accreditation meets the standards required for graduates to apply for a teaching license issued by the Teachers' Council of Thailand, enabling eligibility for professional teaching practice in Thailand. 2. Application Schedule, Selection, and Announcement of Results *(Please note that timelines are subject to change at the discretion of the University.)*

- 2.1 Applications will be accepted until 21 August.
- 2.2 All submitted documents will be reviewed, and application fee payments will be verified.
- 2.3 Eligible applicants will be notified of their interview schedule via email. The announcement of shortlisted applicants will be made on 21 August.
- 2.4 Interviews will be conducted individually through an online platform on 22 August.
- 2.5 Interview results will be communicated to applicants via email on 23 August.
- 2.6 Successful applicants are required to confirm their enrollment by paying the first-semester tuition fee during the registration period, from 24 August to 31 August.
- 2.7 The commencement of classes is scheduled for 17 October 2026.

3. Required Documents for Applicants Currently Employed as School Teachers *(Documents may be submitted as clear photographs or scanned copies.):*

- 3.1 Bachelor's degree certificate and official academic transcript from an accredited institution in any academic discipline. (A Master's degree, if held, may also be submitted.).
- 3.2 For applicants whose first language is not English, appropriate evidence of English-language proficiency is required.
- 3.3 One recent passport-size photograph (1" or 2"), full-face, taken against a plain background, without headwear or sunglasses.
- 3.4 Payment of the non-refundable application fee (THB 4,000).
- 3.5 Copy of a valid passport (information page and relevant visa page).
- 3.6 Copy of a valid work permit (relevant pages).
- 3.7 Copy of a temporary teaching permit or teaching license issued by the Teachers' Council of Thailand (Khurusapha).
- 3.8 Current School Employment Contract in a K-12 School.

4. Program duration and Class schedule

The program spans 1.5 years, divided into 3 terms. Classes will be held exclusively on weekends, either on Saturdays or Sundays, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. However, during the second and third term, students must participate in internship at local schools in order to gain real-world teaching experience **(for teachers, their existing school can also be used as an internship training)**.

3. Guidelines for Teaching Profession Internship courses 146 202 and 146 203

3.1 Arrange work as a school teacher in a recognized school that teaches basic education, including childhood, primary, secondary, or in a higher secondary school.

3.2 Must perform duties as a teacher teaching in a recognized school according to item 1 for not less than 6 hours per week and other administrative work not less than 10 hours per week.

3.3 School that allows teachers enrolled in the program to do Internship should have a supervisor who holds a teaching license.
