## INTERNSHIP SPOTLIGHT: A JOURNEY INTO MEDIA PRODUCTION

Hello! I'm Kunthicha Siriboon, a student from St Teresa International University under the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, majoring in Digital Media. I had the opportunity to complete my internship at 116 Pictures Thailand, where I worked as a Production Assistant (PA). This role serves as an excellent entry point for anyone interested in the production field or aspiring to become a producer, as it offers valuable exposure to every stage of the production process—from groundwork to higher-level management.

As a Production Assistant, my primary responsibility was to support all departments and help ensure that operations on set ran smoothly. This often involved coordinating tasks, addressing unexpected challenges, and assisting team members wherever needed. Since the company specializes in international commercial productions, strong English

communication skills were essential. Being involved in real projects from the outset allowed me to gain hands-on experience, strengthen my adaptability, and develop a strong sense of responsibility.

During my first month, I was assigned to a commercial project for Philips, marking my initial step into the advertising industry. The experience was both exciting and demanding, as I had to collaborate with both Thai and Vietnamese teams while learning workflows in the middle of an active production. With everyone focused on their respective responsibilities, I quickly realized the importance of being proactive—taking initiative, learning independently, and seeking guidance from senior team members when necessary. Asking questions and demonstrating a genuine willingness to learn helped me integrate into the team effectively.

For this project, I was entrusted with taking care of the director, who had traveled from overseas, along with his daughter. The filming took place in April, coinciding with Thailand's Songkran Festival, which added another layer of responsibility as I also acted as a host—providing coordination, assistance, and overall support throughout the production period. The project included both Key Visual (KV) and Television Commercial (TVC) production, spanning more than three weeks of preparation and filming. This comprehensive experience enabled me to understand each phase of production in detail, from pre-production planning to the final shooting days.

Following this project, I had the opportunity to contribute to additional commercial productions for global brands such as Pringles and Colgate. With each project, I became more confident, professional,

and familiar with industry practices. By the end of my internship, I was honored to receive an offer to continue working with the company—an experience that reaffirmed the value of dedication, responsibility, and commitment in opening future opportunities.

To junior students, I would strongly emphasize that an internship is a crucial first step in shaping your career path. It helps you discover your strengths, interests, and the type of work that suits you best. Even if the experience is challenging or not exactly what you expected, it remains highly valuable as it provides real-world exposure and insight. Most importantly, do not be afraid to take opportunities, make mistakes, and learn from them. Give your best effort, stay open to new experiences, and believe in your potential. Every small step you take during your internship can become the foundation of your future success.

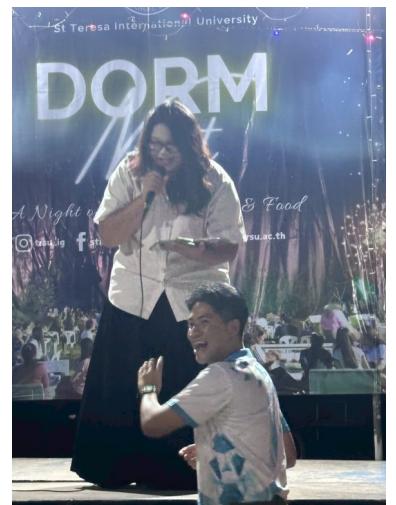
